The Promenade was designed by FFNS Arkitekter, Stockholm.

Ship's signs were designed by the Sign Office, Are Olovsson, Stockholm.

NICE TO KNOW

In the archipelago the speed limit is only a couple of knots, but out at sea the ship's cruising speed is about 22 knots. This means 40 km/h and top speed is 23 knots, about 41.5 km/h.

The ship's frame is built of 80,000 m² of steel plates. This equals a space that is 18 times bigger than Senate Square in Helsinki.

The ship has approx 1,200 showers. At Silja's Ariadne Hotel in Stockholm there are about 300 showers.

On the ship is found 18,200 m² of wall-to-wall carpets. This equals covering two Senate Squares.

Approx. 9 million kilowatt hours have been utilized during the building period of the ship. This is as much energy as 450 Finnish households use yearly on an average.

The electricity generators produce 11,000 kw. This would be enough to light up and keep bright Finland's city of Porvoo.

More than 750 km of cables and electrical wires have been installed on the ship. This equals 1,875 laps in a stadium or the distance between Helsinki to Kemi.

The freshwater tanks on board hold 1,612 m³. At home that would be enough for 9,000 bathtubs.

The restaurants on board can seat 2,450 guests simultaneously.

The height of the ship from its lowest point to the top of the stack is 59 m. The tower of the Olympic Stadium in Helsinki is 72 m.

When the captain stands on the bridge, he sees the water 33 m below him. That is the same as standing on the roof of an 11 story building and looking down at the ground.

The main engine's total capacity is 44,000 hp. That equals - with a good margin - 440 Saab passenger cars.

When painting the ship more than 175,000 liters of paint was used. This equals 8,750 cans of 20-liter paint. The same amount would be enough to paint, for example, 5,000 new single homes.

The radar on board covers 20 sea miles equal to a distance of 37-46 km.

Every cylinder in the main engine has a volume of 96,000 cm³. A moped cylinder has 50 cm³.

The propeller has two propeller shafts. Each one is 55.4 in diameter. A telephone pole has a diameter of about 20 cm.

The ship's propeller shaft is 40 m long.

The ship weighs as much as 21,500 passenger cars. These cars would form a line 90 km long!

The ship has 21,000 lights. If every light burns an average of 3,000 hours, then every eight minutes one burns out.

The Silja seal logo on the ship's stack is 5,5 m high.

The letters in the name Silja Line on the ship's hull are 7 m high.

If the ship departs from Helsinki with all fuel tanks full and if she keeps to a speed of 22 knots, the fuel would take her 12,000 sea miles, about 22,000 km. This would be the same as half way around the globe.

The ship's breaking distance from full speed to full stop is 925 m, equal to 4.5 times the ship's length.

Approx. 2,200 man-years were involved from the project's start to finish. In other words, had one man designed the ship, bought the material and built her, it would have taken him 2,200 years.

The ship costs approx. 45 FIM a kilogram.

The total length of the soft drink, beer and alcohol hose system is about 3.5 km. When there is an average of 8 hoses in a system, the total length of the beer hoses, for example, is about 9.6 km.

When the hoses are cleaned, about 430 liters (54 barrels) of beer go down the drain.

The ship has six 1,000 liter beer tanks and about 40 beer taps.

The personnel needs more than 8,000 pieces of work clothes.

More than 122.5 km of bed linen has been purchased for the ship.

Approx. 25,550 kg (8.5 containers) of china has been supplied to the ship.

When the Silja Serenade cruises from Helsinki to Stockholm or v.v., the following is used:
